Reformation Sunday (also Affirmation of Baptism/Confirmation Sunday) is October 29th and we remember our Lutheran heritage when Martin Luther nailed his 95 theses to the church door 500+ years ago. The reformation lasted between the years 1517 and 1546. "After Luther's death Luther's followers struggled with questions that threatened to split the evangelical movement. Fifty years after the presentation of the Augsburg Confession, they drafted a solution to those questions and pointed to other writings that defined what they believed. This Formula of Concord and those writings were published as *The Book of Concord* (1580) and form the core of Lutheran teaching and shape its preaching."* Pastor Howard has a copy of *The Book of Concord* if you would like to look at it. Let's wear **red** on Reformation Day, and Saturday, October 28th, to celebrate our Lutheran roots and the renewing of the Church through the Holy Spirit!

Will seek one other bid for comparison.
- Discussion was held on the potential costs of replacing A/C and furnace units as they are all original to the building. Wanda will reach out to get an idea of costs.
- An outdoor worship has been scheduled for September 10, 2023 This is also Rally Sunday.
- The Ministry Team for Stewardship shared letters that will be going out to the congregation in August to kick of the Stewardship Campaign, "A grateful response to God's Generosity"
- Several churches will work together August 3, 4, 5 to paint the Barnabus house.
- August 20th Bishop Jones will be here to lead worship. A breakfast will be served following the service. The Saturday night service will not be held.
- Council terms were discussed. We will be looking for 2 new members as Jayne has decided not to serve again, at this time and Carol has served the maximum allowed by the church constitution.
